A Virtual Complete plan ensures your employees can get affordable, high-quality care when and where it works best for them—whether in person, on the job, or from the comfort of home. With our flexible, no-cost telehealth options, and availability of in-person care when needed, your employees are always covered for care no matter how they choose to access it.

How does it work?

With a Virtual Complete plan, employees can connect to their primary care doctor, specialists, and other caregivers by phone or video for a \$0 copay.¹ Employees are also covered for 3 in-person, non-preventive primary care visits per year before meeting their deductible. All preventive in-person care is available at no cost.

With a Virtual Complete plan, your employees can:



Schedule phone visits or face-to-face video visits with their primary care doctor and referred specialists.¹



Get on-demand health support from registered nurses through our 24/7 phone advice line or online chat service.



Describe their health concerns in an online E-visit questionnaire and get personalized advice within a few hours.



Email their doctor's office with nonurgent questions and get a reply within 2 business days.



Fill prescriptions through kp.org or our smartphone app, and have them delivered to their home.²

Virtual care shines in our integrated health system

Our in-person and virtual care capabilities are designed to work together, making care seamless no matter how your employees choose to access it. Every Kaiser Permanente doctor can view and update employees' electronic medical records, which helps them make informed decisions about care, coordinate followup care, suggest preventive care services, and more. This flexibility helps our doctors deliver better care experiences and better health outcomes. It also helps your employees get the care they need, when and where they need it, without coordinating care through third parties.

Virtual care is available for many health conditions and situations:

- Behavioral health concerns and several types of group sessions

- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea (no abdominal pain)
- Minor injuries, aches and pains
- Skin conditions

You must be present in DC, MD, or VA for video visits with your primary care physician or behavioral health provider. For urgent video visits with an emergency doctor, you may also be present in WV, FL, NC, or PA. For video visits with a behavioral health provider, appointments can be scheduled for follow-up care.

² For certain drugs, you can get prescription refills mailed to you through our Kaiser Permanente Mail Order Pharmacy. You should receive them within 3-5 days. If not, please call **1-800-700-1479** (TTY **711**), 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Some medications are not eligible for Mail Order Pharmacy. Mail Order Pharmacy can deliver to addresses in MD, VA, DC, and certain locations outside the service area.
